STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Amend the Purpose of the Maine Institution for
the **Blind**.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The purpose of the Maine Institution for the blind shall
2 be amended by adding in the third line thereof the words,
3 'and for such longer period as may be deemed necessary by
4 the directors of said institution,' and by striking out the
5 figures "57" in line eight and inserting in place thereof the
6 figures '62'; by adding after the word "statutes" the words
7 'and all amendments thereof,' so that said purpose as
8 amended shall read as follows:

'To establish, maintain and operate an institution for the

2 instruction of the blind and to provide a home for them
3 during such period of instruction and for such longer
4 period as may be deemed necessary by the directors of said
5 institution; to acquire, hold and convey real and personal
6 property necessary or incidental to said purposes and to
7 possess all the privileges, rights, powers, and immunities
8 conferred on educational institutions by chapter sixty-two
9 of the revised statutes and all amendments thereof.'
