STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Amend Paragraph IX of Section Six of Chapter Ten of the Revised Statutes, as Amended by Chapter One Hundred Five of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred Nineteen, and as Amended by Chapter One Hundred Nineteen of the Laws of Nineteen Hundred Twenty-one, Relating to exemption from Taxation of the Estates of War Veterans.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Paragraph IX of section six of chapter ten of the Revised
2 Statutes as amended by chapter one hundred five of the
3 Public Laws of nineteen hundred nineteen, and as amended
4 by chapter one hundred nineteen of the laws of nineteen

5 hundred twenty-one, is further amended by adding thereto
6 the following sentence:

‘In the construction of the foregoing paragraph the word
2 ‘widow’ shall be construed to include any woman who would
3 formerly have come within the provision of this act, but
4 has since remarried, providing she again become a widow.’
