Resolved: That there be paid from the state treasury, to 2 be expended under the direction of the governor and council, 3 to the agent of the Passamaquoddy tribe of Indians for the 4 benefit of said tribe for the period from July first, nineteen 5 hundred and twenty-three, to June thirtieth, nineteen hun-6 dred and twenty-five, as follows:


