## STATE OF MAINE

# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Amend Chapter 14 of the Revised Statutes, Relating to Indian Tribes.

Be it Enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter fourteen of the revised statutes is hereby amend-

- 2 ed by adding thereto a section to be numbered section fifty-
- 3 four to read as follows.

'Sect. 54. All the provisions of section twenty-two of

- 2 this chapter shall apply to the Passamaquoddy Tribe of
- 3 Indians as well as to the Penobscot Tribe, except that com-
- 4 plaints under said section relating to the Passamaquoddy
- 5 Tribe shall be made to the judge of the Calais or Eastport
- 6 municipal courts instead of the Oldtown municipal court as
- 7 provided in said section.'
