STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Amend Chapter 14 of the Revised Statutes, Re-
lating to Indian Tribes.

Be it Enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter fourteen of the revised statutes is hereby amend-
ed by adding thereto a section to be numbered section fifty-
four to read as follows.

'Sect. 54. All the provisions of section twenty-two of
this chapter shall apply to the Passamaquoddy Tribe of
Indians as well as to the Penobscot Tribe, except that com-
plaints under said section relating to the Passamaquoddy
Tribe shall be made to the judge of the Calais or Eastport
municipal courts instead of the Oldtown municipal court as
provided in said section.'
