# STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Provide for the Establishment of the Portland Stadium and Athletic Field Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:Section I. A commission, to be styled the Portland Sta-2 dium and Athletic Field Commission, is hereby created.

Sect. 2. The said commission shall consist of five mem-2 bers, including the mayor of the City of Portland ex-officio, 3 and four others, each of whom shall be appointed by the 4 mayor of the City of Portland. One of those first ap-5 pointed shall continue in office one year, one for two, one 6 for three, and the other for four years. At the expiration 7 of each person's term of office, the same or another person

8 shall in like manner be appointed to serve for four years.9 When a vacancy shall happen, another person shall in like10 manner be appointed for the unexpired term.

Sect. 3. The mayor of the City of Portland shall be chair-2 man of the said commission, ex-officio. The members of 3 the said commission shall serve without compensation, and 4 from their own number, elect a secretary and other neces-5 sary officers to serve for one year, or until their successors 6 are elected. The said commission shall have power to adopt 7 rules of procedure and prescribe regulations for the con-8 duct of all business within its jurisdiction. A majority of 9 the membership of the said commission shall constitute a 10 quorum.

Sect. 4. The said commission shall have power to lay 2 out and construct, and to hold, manage, control, lease or 3 let, for the purposes of high school and other athletics and 4 other public events, an athletic field together with bleachers, 5 grand-stands, stadium, locker-houses and other like equip-6 ment; and to receive, hold in trust and expend for the laying 7 out, construction, improvement and enlargement of such 8 athletic field, bleachers, grand-stands, stadium, locker-houses 9 and other like equipment, such gifts and contributions as 10 may from time to time be made to it.

Sect. 5. The revenue derived from the leasing or letting 2 of said land and facilities shall be devoted to the following 3 uses and purposes:

First: To the up-keep and maintenance of said land, in-

2 cluding the improvements and structures thereon.

Second: To the improvements, extension, and enlarge-2 ment of said grounds and structures and for the construc-3 tion of additional facilities for the purposes recited in sec-4 tion four and for the development and encouragement of 5 community interests requiring such grounds and facilities.

Sect. 6. The city council may, by ordinance from time 2 to time hereafter, permit the Portland Stadium and Ath-3 letic Field Commission to have the permanent use of any 4 lands now held by the city or hereafter acquired by it by 5 gift, devise, purchase, lease or license, and said city council 6 may also, by ordinance or otherwise, transfer from the care 7 of the Park Commission or Recreation Commission, or 8 both, to the permanent charge, custody and control of the 9 Portland Stadium and Athletic Field Commission any land 10 adaptable for the purposes of the said Portland Stadium 11 and Athletic Field Commission and by such ordinances de-12 termine the time, terms and conditions of said transfer.

Sect. 7. This act shall not limit or affect in any way the 2 authority conferred by law upon the park commission of 3 said city to lay out and improve the public parks, prom-4 enades, squares, cemeteries and public grounds in said city, 5 nor shall it apply to any land acquired by the city by gift, 6 devise, purchase or otherwise for park purposes.

Sect. 8. The City of Portland is hereby authorized and 2 empowered to assist in the underdraining, grading, leveling, 3 and surfacing of said grounds but shall not appropriate

4 money for any other improvements upon said grounds.

Sect. 9. The Portland Stadium and Athletic Field Com-2 mission shall annually make a report of its proceedings to 3 the city council.

Sect. 10. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith 2 are hereby repealed.
