STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

RESOLVE, to Increase the Salmon on the Maine Coast.

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated five
2 hundred dollars annually for the purchase of salmon by
3 the director of sea and shore fisheries to be tagged and
4 liberated in the rivers of the state above the dams to breed
5 naturally and remain the property of the state so long as
6 they live.

Any person having tagged salmon in his possession shall
2 be fined one hundred dollars for each salmon, said fine to
3 be recovered by complaint, indictment or action of debt.
