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AN ACT to Amend Section One Hundred and Twenty-two of Chapter Four of the Revised Statutes, Relating to License for Building a Fish Weir or Trap.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section one hundred and twenty-two of chapter four of 2 the revised statutes is hereby amended by inserting in the 3 third line of said section between the word "section" and the 4 word "shall," the following: 'or any right or privilege 5 granted by the legislature for the building or extension of 6 any such fish weir or trap,' and after the word "license" 7 in the fourth line, the words, 'or the granting of such right

8 or privilege,' so that said section, as amended, shall read  
9 as follows:

'Sect. 122. The license for the building or extension of a  
2 fish weir or trap issued under the provisions of the preced-  
3 ing section or any right or privilege granted by the legisla-  
4 ture for the building or extension of any such fish weir or  
5 trap shall terminate and become void unless such weir or  
6 trap shall have been or shall be built within two years from  
7 the date of the license or the granting of such right or  
8 privilege and maintained and operated in good faith for  
9 some part of each year thereafter.'
