## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT for the Better Protection of Salmon, Shad, Alewives and Smelts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

All sea salmon, shad, alewives and smelts that migrate

- 2 from the ocean into fresh water shall be under the con-
- 3 current jurisdiction of the sea and shore fisheries and the
- 4 inland fish and game commissioner wherever found.
