STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Amend Chapter Thirty-eight of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Nineteen, Relative to Retiring and Pensioning Employees of the State.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Chapter thirty-eight of the public laws of nineteen hundred2 and nineteen is hereby amended by adding to said act the3 following sections:

'Sect. 3. The word "employee" defined. The word em-2 ployee shall be held to include clerks and other employees 3 of the several state departments and state institutions; also 4 teachers in the state normal schools, including such teachers 5 as have retired since March first, nineteen hundred and 6 twenty.'

'Sect. 4. No person receiving retirement pay under this 2 act shall receive retirement pay under any other act.'

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
