IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Establish a Ferry Across Somes Sound Between Southwest Harbor and Northeast Harbor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Clifford M. Robbins, his associates and assigns,

- 2 are vested with the right to ply a ferry-boat or boats across
- 3 Somes sound, between Southwest Harbor and Northeast
- 4 Harbor in the county of Hancock, for the term of ten years,
- 5 to the exclusion of all other persons, and collect tolls at the
- 6 rate of fifty cents for each person, one dollar for each team
- 7 and driver and one dollar and a half for each automobile
- 8 and driver.

Sect. 2. Every keeper of this ferry is subject to the re-2 quirements of section three of chapter twenty-seven of the 3 revised statutes.
