STATE OF MAINE

**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE**

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Maine School for Feeble Minded
for Additions and Improvements.

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated for
2 the Maine school for feeble minded for new construction
3 and improvements for the period from July first, nineteen
4 hundred twenty-four to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred
5 twenty-five, the sum of one hundred forty thousand dollars
6 to be spent by the trustees of the institution, under the
7 direction of the governor and council.

Provided, further, that the sum herein appropriated shall
2 be expended as follows:

Build one dormitory, provide necessary equipment, heat,
2 light, water and sewerage connections.

Provided that any balance of the sum above appropriated
2 for the year nineteen hundred twenty-four which may re-
3 main unexpended at the end of the period June thirtieth,
4 nineteen hundred twenty-five, shall be available for expendi-
5 ture, during the period July first, nineteen hundred twenty-
6 five to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred twenty-six.
