STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Constitute the State Superintendent of Schools a Member, Ex-Officio, of the Board of Trustees of the University of Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

As the state is providing large appropriations for the sup-2 port of the University of Maine, the state should have a 3 more direct connection with its affairs both financial and 4 educational, therefore, it is provided that the state super-5 intendent of public schools shall be ex-officio a member of 6 the board of trustees of the University of Maine with all 7 of the powers and privileges of members and that his mem-8 bership on said board shall be coetaneous with his term of

9 office as state superintendent of public schools.
