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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE

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AN ACT to Amend Section Thirty-three of Chapter Fifty-one of the Revised Statutes, Relating to Corporations.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section thirty-three of chapter fifty-one of the revised  
2 statutes is hereby amended by inserting after the word  
3 "business" in the second line the words 'and that it is not  
4 indebted to the state on account of franchise taxes,' so  
5 that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect 33. The attorney general, upon application by any  
2 corporation, and satisfactory proof that it has ceased to  
3 transact business, and that it is not indebted to the state  
4 on account of franchise taxes, shall file a certificate of the

5 fact with the secretary of state, and shall give a duplicate  
6 certificate to the corporation; and thereupon such corpora-  
7 tion shall be excused from filing annual returns with the  
8 secretary of state.'
