**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE**

AN ACT to Repeal Section Eight of Chapter Five Hundred and Twenty-two of the Private and Special Laws of 1885, and to Amend Section One of Chapter Nine of the Private and Special Laws of 1887, Relating to the Camden and Rockland Water Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section eight of chapter five hundred and
2 twenty-two of the private and special laws of eighteen hun-
3 dred and eighty-five is hereby repealed.

Sect. 2. Section one of chapter nine of the private and
2 special laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-seven is hereby
3 amended so that it shall read as follows:

'Sect. 1. The Camden and Rockland Water Company, a

2 corporation created by special act of the legislature and
 3 charged with the performance of a public duty, is hereby
 4 authorized to increase its capital stock to not exceeding one
 5 million dollars. The stock authorized by this act may be
 6 issued either as common or preferred, from time to time
 7 and upon such terms and conditions as the corporation may
 8 determine; provided, however, that the issue of such capital
 9 stock shall be subject to the provisions of section thirty-
 10 seven, chapter fifty-five of the revised statutes, and acts
 11 amendatory thereof; and it may hold real and personal
 12 estate for the purposes of the corporation to an amount
 13 not exceeding said sum.'
