STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT in Relation to Standard Time.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. That, within the state of Maine, the standard
2 time shall be based on the mean astronomical time of the
3 seventy-fifth degree of longitude west from Greenwich,
4 known and designated by the federal statute as "United
5 States Standard Eastern Time." It shall be unlawful for
6 any town or other municipality to vote for, or otherwise
7 establish, any other system of time.

Sect. 2. Any violation of the provisions of this act shall
2 be punishable by a fine not exceeding five hundred dollars
3 (\$500 00).
