RESOLVE, in Favor of Highmoor Farm, in the Town of Monmouth.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the

- 2 sum of five thousand dollars for the year from July first.
- 3 nineteen hundred and twenty-five, to June thirtieth, nineteen
- 4 hundred and twenty-six, and five thousand dollars for the
- 5 year from July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-six, to
- 6 June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-seven, for the
- 7 maintenance of Highmoor Farm, in the town of Monmouth.
- 8 Said sum to be expended under the direction of the Maine
- 9 Agricultural Experiment Station.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This resolve provides the regular appropriation made for many years by the legislature for the support and maintenance of Highmoor Farm, in the town of Monmouth.
