HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE.

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RESOLVE, in Favor of Animal Husbandry:

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*Resolved:* That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the  
2 sum of five thousand dollars for the year from July first,  
3 nineteen hundred and twenty-five, to June thirtieth, nineteen  
4 hundred and twenty-six, and five thousand dollars for the  
5 year from July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-six, to  
6 June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-seven, for sci-  
7 entific investigation in animal husbandry. Said sum to be  
8 expended under the direction of the Maine Agricultural  
9 Experiment Station.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

This resolve continues the appropriation made by the state for many years, and is for the purpose of continuing the valuable animal husbandry investigation and study, now being carried on at Highmoor Farm.
