IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Scientific Investigation in Agriculture
in Aroostook County.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the
2 sum of five thousand dollars for the year from July first,
3 nineteen hundred and twenty-five, to June thirtieth, nineteen
4 hundred and twenty-six, and five thousand dollars for the
5 year from July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-six, to
6 June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-seven, for sci-
7 entific investigation in agriculture in Aroostook County.
8 Said sum to be expended under the direction of the Maine
9 Agricultural Experiment Station.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This resolve carries the regular appropriation for the continuance of scientific investigation in agriculture at the Aroostook Farm, owned by the state near Presque Isle.
