## STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Define the Surplus Revenue Account.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The treasurer of state and the state auditor shall carry 2 upon their books an account called surplus revenue in which 3 shall be entered the appropriations made by the legislature, 4 except those continuing by law, and the revenue of the 5 state from all sources applicable under existing law to meet 6 the ordinary expenses of the state. There shall also be 7 credited to said account on December thirty-one of each 8 year all unexpended balances of appropriations made by the

9 legislature not continuing by law. A detailed statement of 10 said surplus revenue account shall be reported by the treas-11 urer of state and the state auditor to the legislature on the 12 fifth day of each session. The governor and council shall 13 not draw from said surplus revenue account any sum what-14 ever without authority by act of the legislature.
