IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Establish Close Time on Lobsters West of Petit

Manan Point.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter seventy-five of the private and special laws of 2 nineteen hundred twenty-three is hereby amended by strik-

- 3 ing out all of section chapter, and inserting in place thereof
- 4 the following:
- 'Sect. 1. No person or persons shall set any traps or
- 2 other devices used for catching lobsters between the first
- 3 day of July, and nine o'clock in the forenoon of August
- 4 thirty-first of each year, under penalty of five dollars for
- 5 each trap, or other device set within the following described

- 6 limits: Beginning at Bear Cove, on the western side of
- 7 Petit Manan Point, to Little Black ledge; thence in a south-
- 8 westerly direction to Schoodic Island whistling buoy.'
