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## STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

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AN ACT to Authorize the Filing by the United States in the  
Several Counties of This State of Notices of Liens for  
Taxes.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Notices of liens for internal revenue taxes  
2 payable to the United States of America, and certificates  
3 discharging such liens, prepared in accordance with the laws  
4 of the United States pertaining thereto, may be filed in any  
5 county in the State of Maine in the registry of deeds for  
6 that county or counties within which the property subjected  
7 to such lien is situated.

Sect. 2. Registers of deeds shall receive, record and index  
2 such notices and discharges in the same manner as similar  
3 instruments are recorded and indexed.

Sect. 3. The fee to be paid by the United States to reg-  
2 isters of deeds for recording each such notice or discharge,  
3 is fifty cents, which need not be prepaid.

Sect. 4. This act is passed for the purpose of author-  
2 izing the filing of notices of liens in accordance with the  
3 provisions of section 3186 of the revised statutes of the  
4 United States, as amended by act of March 4, 1913—37  
5 statutes at large, page 1016.
