STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to the Taking of Smelts in Casco Bay.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter one hundred and thirty-two of the public laws of 2 nineteen hundred and twenty-three is hereby amended by 3 adding thereto the following sentence: 'And this act shall 4 not apply to smelts taken in Casco bay between the fifteenth 5 day of September and the first day of October of each 6 year,' so that said chapter, as amended, shall read as fol-7 lows:

'No smelts shall be taken or fished for in any waters of 2 the state between the first day of April and the first day 3 of October of each year except by hook and line. Any one 4 violating any provision of this act shall be punished by a

5 fine of one hundred dollars for each offense. Nothing in 6 this act shall apply to smelts taken in fish weirs or traps 7 maintained and operated for the catching of sardines or 8 herring. And this act small not apply to smelts taken in 9 Casco bay between the fifteenth day of September and the 10 first day of October of each year.'
