STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Designation of a Certain Day in
February of Each Year as "Potato Day."

Whereas, it is believed that the future prosperity of the
2 State of Maine depends in a large measure upon the potato
3 industry, and

Whereas, to insure the permanence and success of said
2 industry, all the people of Maine must in some substantial
3 way demonstrate their interest and good will toward the
4 "King" of vegetables,

Now Therefore Be It Resolved: That the governor be,
2 and hereby is, authorized to designate a certain day in
3 February of each year, as "Potato Day," on which all our

4 people may arrange a strictly potato diet to the end that their
5 physical condition may be improved and the material wel-
6 fare of the state may be conserved.
