STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Increasing the State Aid Provided for the Maine
State Agricultural Society.

Resolved: That the amount annually appropriated by the
2 state for the Maine State Agricultural Society under the
3 provisions of chapter one hundred and thirty, resolves of
4 nineteen hundred and thirteen, be increased to five thousand
5 dollars beginning with the fiscal year ending June thirtieth,
6 nineteen hundred and twenty-six.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The Maine State Agricultural Society receives under chapter 170, resolves of 1913, an annual allowance from the state of twenty-five hundred dollars. Since this resolve was passed the society has greatly increased its equipment and enlarged its premium list and has paid out in recent years some nine thousand dollars annually in premiums on live stock and agricultural products. The society is carrying a very considerable debt at the present time and asks this increase in the stipend allowed by the state in order that it may continue and increase still further its premiums on agricultural and live stock exhibits.
