STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Amend Section One of Chapter Nine of the
Private and Special Laws of Eighteen Hundred and Eighty-
seven, Relating to the Camden and Rockland Water Com-
pany.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section one of chapter nine of the private and special laws
2 of eighteen hundred and eighty-seven is hereby amended
3 so that it shall read as follows:

'Section 1. The Camden and Rockland Water Company,
2 a corporation created by special act of the legislature and
3 charged with the performance of a public duty, is hereby
4 authorized to increase its capital stock to an amount not

5 exceeding one million dollars. The stock authorized by this
6 act may be issued either as common or preferred, from
7 time to time and upon such terms and conditions as the
8 corporation may determine; provided, however, that the
9 issue of such capital stock shall be subject to the provisions
10 of section thirty-seven, chapter fifty-five of the revised stat-
11 utes, and acts amendatory thereof; and it may hold real
12 and personal estate for the purposes of the corporation to
13 an amount not exceeding said sum.'
