STATE OF MAINE

**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE**

AN ACT Relative to Fishing in Moose River, Somerset
County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to catch any fish in Moose
2 River from Brassua Lake to its headwaters after August
3 fifteenth of each year, unless by artificial flies.

Sect. 2. This is not to include Long Pond, Wood Pond
2 or Attian Pond.

All laws inconsistent with the above is hereby repealed.
