IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Applications for Soldiers' Bonus.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

2 application for soldiers' bonus, amended. Section three of

P. L. 1919, c. 264; 1921, c. 100; 1923, c. 55; relation to

- 3 chapter two hundred and sixty-four of the public laws of
- 4 nineteen hundred and nineteen, as amended by chapter one
- 5 hundred of the public laws of nineteen hundred and twenty-
- 6 one and chapter fifty-five of the public laws of nineteen 7 hundred and twenty-three is hereby further amended by
- 8 striking out the word "twenty-two" in the third line thereof
- 9 and inserting in place thereof the word 'twenty-nine,' so
- 10 that said section, as amended, shall read as follows:

'Sect. 3. Time extended to December 31, 1928. Applica-2 tions for such bonus shall be filed with the adjutant general, 3 on forms provided by him, before the first day of January, 4 nineteen hundred twenty-seven. Such application shall state 5 facts sufficient to establish the status of such applicant as 6 soldier as defined herein, and shall be duly verified.'
