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**STATE OF MAINE**

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

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AN ACT to Permit the Good Will Home Association to Hold  
Property to Any Amount.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section one of chapter four hundred and fifty-five of the  
2 private and special laws of the year one thousand eight  
3 hundred and ninety-seven, as amended by chapter one hun-  
4 dred and ten of the private and special laws of one thousand  
5 nine hundred and nine is hereby amended by striking out  
6 after the word "estate" in the sixth line thereof, the words  
7 "in all not exceeding twelve hundred thousand dollars owned  
8 at any one time," and substituting therefor the words 'to any  
9 amount,' so that said section, as amended shall read as  
10 follows:

‘Section 1. The Good Will Home Association, a charitable  
2 corporation formed under the provisions of Chapter fifty-  
3 five of the Revised Statutes, for the purpose of aiding needy  
4 boys, and located at East Fairfield in Somerset County, is  
5 hereby authorized to take and hold by purchase, gift, devise  
6 or bequest, personal or real estate to any amount.’
