STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Amending Chapter Two Hundred and Four, Section Eleven of the Public Laws of Eighteen Hundred Fifty-six, as Amended, Relating to the Powers of the Recorder of the Portland Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section eleven of chapter two hundred four of the public 2 laws of eighteen hundred fifty-six as amended by chapter 3 twenty-nine of the public laws of eighteen hundred eighty- 4 seven is hereby amended by inserting after the word "inter- 5 ested" the words 'or when the judge is present and so di- 6 rects,' so that said section, as amended, shall read as fol- 7 lows:

'Sect. 11. When the judge is absent or is interested, or
2 when the judge is present and so directs, it shall be the duty
3 of the recorder, and he shall have authority to exercise all
4 the powers of the judge.'
