STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Amend Chapter Two Hundred Sixteen of the
Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred Three, Pertaining to the
School Board of the City of Brewer.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section one of chapter two hundred and six-
2 teen of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred
3 three is hereby amended by striking out the word "three"
4 in the second line and inserting the word 'five'; also by
5 striking out the word "three" in the fourth line and insert-
6 ing the word 'five'; also by striking out the word "three"
7 in the ninth line and inserting the word 'five,' so that said
8 section when amended shall read as follows:

'Section 1. The school board of the city of Brewer shall

2 consist of five members, who shall be chosen by the city
3 council in the following manner, namely: at the first meet-
4 ing of the city council after the passage of this act, five
5 citizens of the city, either male or female, shall be chosen
6 to serve as members of the school board, who shall hold
7 office as provided in section two of this act, and each suc-
8 ceeding year the incoming council shall, at its first meeting,
9 choose one member of said school board, who shall serve
10 for five years, to take the place of the retiring member, as
11 provided in said section two of this act, and all vacancies
12 in said school board shall be filled by the city council for
13 the remainder of the term in which the same occur.'

Sect. 2. Section two of said act is hereby amended by
2 striking out the word "three" in the third line of said sec-
3 tion and inserting the word 'five'; also striking out the word
4 "two" in the fourth line and inserting the words 'four, three
5 and two," so that said section when amended shall read as
6 follows:

'Sect. 2. The school board so chosen by the city council
2 in March, nineteen hundred and three, shall, at its first meet-
3 ing decide by lot, which of its members shall serve for five
4 years, which for four years, which for three years, which
5 for two years, and the remaining member shall serve for
6 one year, and shall be chairman of the board for that year;
7 and each subsequent year, the member whose term of office
8 expires at the end of that year, shall be the chairman of
9 the board.'
