STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Requiring Physical Examination Before Issuance of a Marriage License.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Section 1. No city, town or plantation clerk shall issue
- 2 a marriage license to any person unless a certificate be filed
- 3 with said clerk by each of the contracting parties from a
- 4 legally qualified physician showing that such persons have
- 5 no venereal diseases. Gonorrhea and syphilis shall be des-
- 6 ignated as venereal diseases.
 - Sect. 2. Any city, town or plantation clerk who issues a
- 2 license to any person without such certificates from a legally
- 3 qualified physician or physicians shall be fined not less than
- 4 fifty dollars nor more than one hundred dollars for each
- 5 offense.
