STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the Judge of the Municipal
Court of Portland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section three of chapter one hundred fifty of the Private
2 and Special Laws of eighteen hundred ninety-one, as amend-
3 ed by section one of chapter five hundred fifteen of the
4 Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred ninety-seven,
5 as further amended by chapter twenty-three of the Private
6 and Special Laws of nineteen hundred fifteen, is further
7 amended by striking out the word "eighteen" in the second
8 line of said section as amended and inserting in place thereof
9 the word 'twenty-five,' so that said section, as amended, shall
10 read as follows:

'Sect. 3. The salary of the judge of said court shall be
2 twenty-five hundred dollars per annum, payable quarterly, in
3 full for all services.'
