STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Increasing the Amount to be Paid for Clerk Hire in the Office of the Recorder of the Municipal Court of the City of Portland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section Forty-five of Chapter One hundred and Seventeen
2 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by Chapter forty-two of
3 the Public Laws of 1917, as amended by Section forty-five of
4 Chapter two hundred nineteen of the Public Laws of 1921,
5 is hereby amended by striking out in the fourth paragraph
6 thereof after the words "Portland Municipal Court" the
7 words "Sixteen hundred and twelve" and inserting in place
8 thereof the words 'nineteen hundred seventy-six,' so that
9 said paragraph four of said section shall read as follows:

'Clerk hire in office of recorder of Portland municipal 2 court increased to \$1976. Cumberland County; for clerks 3 in the office of register of deeds, thirty-eight hundred and 4 fifty-two dollars; deputy register of deeds, eleven hundred 5 and forty-four dollars; for clerks in the office of register of 6 probate, thirty-two hundred and seventy-two dollars; for 7 clerks in the office of clerk of courts, forty-three hundred 8 and twenty-four dollars; for clerks in the office of recorder 9 of the Portland municipal court, nineteen hundred and 10 seventy-six dollars; for clerks in the office of county at-11 torney, seven hundred and forty-two dollars, for clerks in 12 the office of sheriff, seven hundred twenty-eight dollars; for 13 clerks in the office of county treasurer, seven hundred and 14 twenty-eight dollars.'
