STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Change the Name of the Trustees of Gould's Academy in Bethel Originally Incorporated under the Name of the Trustees of Bethel Academy and Later Changed to the Trustees of Gould's Academy in Bethel.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The trustees of Gould's Academy in Bethel, 2 are hereby authorized to take, and shall be hereafter known 3 by, the corporate name of the Trustees of Gould Academy 4 in Bethel, in substitution for the name and style by which 5 they are now called and known.

Sect. 2. The said trustees shall be entitled to, and are 2 hereby secured in, all the rights, privileges and immunities,

3 and shall be subject to all the liabilities and duties, under
4 the name and styles of the trustees of Gould Academy in
5 Bethel, as they have heretofore enjoyed and been subject to,
6 by virtue of any and all provisions of the original act of
7 incorporation above referred to and the act approved Feb-
8 ruary 3, 1843, changing the name as above stated.
