IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Extend the Open Time for Smelt Fishing in the
Tide Waters of the Penobscot River and its Tributaries.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

There is hereby created an open time in which it shall be
2 lawful to fish for and take smelts from the tide waters of
3 the Penobscot river and its tributaries between the first day
4 of October and the first day of May. Any fish so taken
5 from said waters may be offered for sale and sold within
6 the state or shipped to such places out of the state as the
7 owner may designate.
