STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to the Exemption from Attachment and Execution of Certain Personal Property.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sub-section one of section sixty-four of chapter eighty-

- 2 six of the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking
- 3 out the fifth, sixth and seventh words in the second line
- 4 of said sub-section one, and substituting therefor the words
- 5 'five hundred dollars,' so that said sub-section as amended
- 6 shall read as follows:

'Sub-section 1. Exemption of certain personal property

- 2 from attachment and execution. The debtor's apparel;
- 3 household furniture necessary for himself, wife and chil-
- 4 dren, not exceeding five hundred dollars in value, and one

5 bed, bedstead and necessary bedding for every two such 6 persons.'
