STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Meetings of Municipal Officers to Accept Legacies and Gifts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section sixty-nine of chapter four of the revised statutes, 2 nineteen hundred sixteen, is hereby repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Section 69 of Chapter 4, R. S. 1916, should be repealed, as it is diametrically opposed to Section 13, of Chapter 21, R. S. 1916, as amended by Chapter 103 of the Public Laws of 1921, and Section 64 of Chapter 68, R. S. 1916, and conflicts with the operation and intent of said opposed sections.
