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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

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AN ACT Relating to Itinerant Vendors.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter forty-one of the Revised Statutes as amended  
2 by chapter one hundred twenty-nine of the Public Laws of  
3 nineteen hundred nineteen is hereby amended by striking  
4 out in the sixth, seventh and eighth lines of section twenty-  
5 six thereof, the words "or of any other state or country  
6 whose laws impose no burden upon citizens of this state  
7 engaged in like business within their borders," so that said  
8 section, as amended, shall read as follows:

'Sect. 26. The provisions of the fifteen preceding sections  
2 shall not apply to sales made to dealers by commercial

3 travelers or selling agents in the usual course of business,  
4 nor to bona fide sales of goods, wares and merchandise by  
5 sample for future delivery, nor to hawkers or peddlers on  
6 the streets or peddlers from vehicles, any of whom are bona  
7 fide residents of this state.'
