STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Appropriating Money to Aid in the Screening of
Schoodic Lake, in Township Four, Range Eight, Piscataquis
County.

Resolved: That the sum of five hundred dollars be, and
2 is hereby appropriated, to be taken from the appropriation
3 for the maintenance of the department of inland fisheries
4 and game, for the purpose of establishing a fish screen at
5 a suitable point on the outlet of Schoodic lake, in Township
6 Four, Range Eight, in the county of Piscataquis, said money
7 hereby appropriated to be expended under the direction of
8 the commissioner of inland fisheries and game.

Provided, however, that this appropriation shall not be

2 available until some responsible corporation or incorporated
3 fish and game club or association, or the town in which the
4 outlet of said lake is situated, or some other town in the
5 county in which said lake is situated, shall have, in legal
6 town meeting, and having an article in the warrant for said
7 town meeting for that purpose, by vote of record, voted
8 to assume all liability for the keeping of said screen at all
9 times in repair and free from sticks, leaves and all debris,
10 so that the same will not become clogged and prevent the
11 free running of water through the same; and provided,
12 further, that said appropriation shall not be available until
13 the citizens of the county in which said lake to be screened
14 is situated, shall have paid into the state treasury the bal-
15 ance necessary, as found by the commissioner of inland
16 fisheries and game, to erect said screen. If this appropri-
17 ation, or part thereof, is not expended during the fiscal
18 year ending June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-
19 six, it shall be available during the fiscal year ending June
20 thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-seven.

For screening the outlet of Schoodic lake, in Town-
ship Four, Range Eight, Piscataquis county, five
hundred dollars,
