STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Regulating the Parking of Automobiles Around
Public Buildings.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The official or officials having charge, custody or control
2 of public buildings owned and occupied by the federal gov-
3 ernment, the state or any county may by appropriate order
4 restrict the right of parking vehicles upon portions of ways
5 and streets abutted by the lot on which such building stands,
6 to persons or officials therein designated, permitting park-
7 ing by such persons or officials for such periods of time as
8 they may determine, but such orders shall not otherwise
9 be repugnant to or inconsistent with any existing ordinance
10 or by-law.

For violation of the provisions of any such restriction a
2 penalty of five dollars may be imposed by any municipal
3 or police court or trial justice having jurisdiction; provided
4 that it shall be a defense to any prosecution under this act,
5 that no signs or notices reasonably indicating the nature and
6 scope of such restriction were maintained so as to be seen
7 on the premises involved.
