# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Authorizing the Employment of Stenographers by Justices of the Supreme Judicial and Superior Courts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Each justice of the supreme judicial and superior courts

- 2 is authorized to employ a stenographer at a salary not to
- 3 exceed one thousand dollars per year, which salary shall
- 4 be paid from the state treasury.
