STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Support of Paupers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section thirty-three of chapter twenty-nine of the revised
2 statutes is hereby amended by striking out the words "three
3 months" in the fourth and fifth lines thereof, and inserting
4 in place thereof the words 'thirty days,' so that said section,
5 as amended, shall read as follows:

'Sect. 33. Overseers shall relieve persons destitute, found
2 in their towns and having no settlement therein, and in case
3 of death, decently bury them, or dispose of their bodies
4 according to section three of chapter eighteen; the expenses
5 whereof and of their removal incurred within thirty days
6 before notice given to the town chargeable, may be recov-

7 tred of the town liable, by the town incurring them, in an
8 action commenced within two years after the cause of ac-
9 tion accrued, and not otherwise; and may be recovered of
10 their kindred in the manner before provided in this chapter.'
