STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Regulate Fishing in the Brooks in York, in the
County of York.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to fish for,
2 take, catch or kill any kind of fish at any time in any of the
3 fresh water brooks in the town of York, in the county of
4 York, except during the months of May and June of each
5 year, during which months it shall be lawful to fish in said
6 brooks in accordance with the general law of the State.

It shall also be unlawful for any person to have in posses-
2 sion any kind of fish at any time taken in violation of any
3 provision of this section.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any provision of this act shall
2 be subject to a penalty of not less than ten dollars nor more
3 than thirty dollars and costs for each offense, and an addi-
4 tional penalty of one dollar for each fish taken, caught,
5 killed or had in possession in violation of any provision of
6 this act.

Sect. 3. Trial Justices, Police and Municipal Courts, with-
2 in their respective counties, shall have, upon complaint, orig-
3 inal and concurrent jurisdiction with the Supreme Judicial
4 Court and Superior Courts in all prosecutions arising under
5 this act.
