STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Abolishment of Grade Crossings.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section thirty-four, chapter twenty-four of the revised 2 statutes of Maine, revision of nineteen hundred and six-3 teen, is hereby amended by striking out the fifth sentence 4 thereof which now reads: "The commission shall determine 5 and fix the damages sustained by any person whose land 6 is taken and the special damages which the owner of land 7 adjoining the public way may sustain by reason of any 8 change in the grade of such way," and substituting there-9 for the following:

'The commission shall determine how much land may be

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2 taken and shall fix the damages sustained by any person3 whose land is taken and the special damages which the4 owner of land adjoining the public way may sustain by5 reason of any change in the grade of such way.'

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
