STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to the Insurance Laws.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

That section five of chapter fifty-three of the Revised
2 Statutes is hereby amended by inserting after the word
3 "insured" in the ninth line of the eighth paragraph of said
4 section the following sentence:

'It shall be the duty of the Insurance Company to furnish
2 the insured in case of loss or damage under its policy a
3 blank form approved by the Insurance Commissioner which
4 shall comply with the requirements of this paragraph,' so
5 that said section as amended will read as follows:

'In case of any loss or damage under this policy, a state-

2 ment in writing, signed and sworn to by the insured, shall
3 be within a reasonable time rendered to the company setting
4 forth the value of the property insured, the interest of the
5 insured therein, all other insurance thereon, in detail, the
6 purposes for which and the persons by whom the building
7 insured, or containing the property insured, was used and
8 the time at which and manner in which the fire originated,
9 so far as known to the insured: It shall be the duty of the
10 Insurance Company to furnish the insured in case of loss
11 or damage under its policy a blank form approved by the
12 Insurance Commissioner which shall comply with the re-
13 quirements of this paragraph. The company may also ex-
14 amine the books of account and vouchers of the insured, and
15 make extracts from the same.'
