AN ACT Relating to Provision for Upkeep, Equipment and Extensions for the Several Normal Schools and the Madawaska Training School.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter two hundred seventeen of the public laws of nineteen hundred nineteen and chapter one hundred seventy-one of the public laws of nineteen hundred twenty-three is hereby amended by adding at the close of the chapter the following words: 'This appropriation shall constitute a carrying account,' so that the chapter, as amended, shall read **as follows:**

'In order to provide for the need of more and better  
2 trained teachers for the schools of the state, the board of  
3 trustees of the state normal schools is hereby authorized to  
4 provide for upkeep, equipment and extensions of the several  
5 normal schools and the Madawaska Training School, for  
6 which purpose there shall be appropriated the sum of sev-  
7 enty thousand dollars for the fiscal year nineteen hundred  
8 and twenty-four, seventy thousand dollars for the fiscal year  
9 nineteen hundred and twenty-five, and sixty thousand dol-  
10 lars annually thereafter, to be expended under the direction  
11 of the board of state normal school trustees, for extensions  
12 in buildings, repairs and equipment. The amount provided  
13 for in this chapter shall be deducted from the state school  
14 fund. This appropriation shall constitute a carrying ac-  
15 count.'
