IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Certain Exemptions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter ten of the revised statutes as amended by chapter
2 two hundred eighty-five of the public laws of nineteen
3 hundred seventeen is hereby amended by striking out the
4 whole of paragraph VI of section ten thereof and insert-
5 ing in place thereof the following, so that said paragraph
6 as amended, shall read as follows:

‘VI. All mules and horses less than six months old, three
2 horses of any age, all cattle under the age of two years,
3 ten head of cattle above the age of two years, three hun-
4 dred hens, all sheep to the number of thirty-five and all
5 swine to the number of ten.’
