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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

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*Ordered*, the senate concurring, that all corporations engaged in transportation business, whether of individuals or of property or both, which have or shall, make application for reduction of taxes and whether such application be made by corporations known as railroad or railway companies, be, and the same are, hereby required to furnish to this legislature an account in detail to the following effect: The salaries paid to each and all the officials thereof; also the average wage paid per day to its engineers, firemen and other employees, the same to be shown when grouped into the several departments of the company, all of the foregoing to be shown for the year nineteen hundred twenty-four.
