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**STATE OF MAINE**

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

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AN ACT Relating to State Highways and to the Creation of  
Further Revenues.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter two hundred sixteen of the public laws of nineteen hundred twenty-three is hereby amended by adding 3 at the end of section one thereof, as amended, the following: 'A further tax of one and one-quarter mills on a 5 dollar shall be assessed annually upon all property of the 6 state according to the value thereof; this fund so established shall be apportioned by the state highway commission among the various towns to be expended for the permanent improvement of the third class roads according to

10 the number of miles of unimproved continuous roads there-  
11 in, provided, however, that said tax of one and one-quarter  
12 mills shall not be effective unless the state shall authorize  
13 an amount for third class roads annually in addition to  
14 the fund created by the assessment of said one and one-  
15 quarter mills which shall equal the amount raised under  
16 an act of the legislature of the year nineteen hundred  
17 twenty-three.'
